Concrete or Metal Encapsulant

DESCRIPTION: BRIDGE-CON™ is specifically designed for encapsulating concrete or metal substructure components that have been exposed to corrosive chlorides. BRIDGE-CON™ is also excellent for protecting metal, wood and concrete components of bridges or salt storage domes.

SURFACE PREPARATION - CONCRETE: Always apply to a clean, dry surface, free of loose dirt and debris. Rhomar recommends cleaning surfaces that have been exposed to deicing chlorides with NEUTRO-WASH™ Chloride Neutralizer prior to application of BRIDGE-CON™.

SURFACE PREPARATION - Metal: Rhomar suggests applying BLACK-MAX Cathodic Rust Arrestor, as a primer to rusty metal components prior to application of BRIDGE-CON™.

METHOD OF APPLICATION: Rhomar recommends applying BRIDGE-CON™ with the BRIDGE-CON PISTOL-GRIP Spray Gun or by rolling with a thick nap roller. Apply product above 50°F.

CLEAN UP OF BRIDGE-CON™: When BRIDGE-CON™ is wet, you may clean tools and overspray with soap and water. When cured, remove with toluene or by sandblasting or with grinding wheel.

COVERAGE OF BRIDGE-CON™: Approximately 25-100 sq ft per gallon depending on porosity of substrate. Apply BRIDGE-CON™ to wet film thickness (WFT) of 15-20 mils.
