DESCRIPTION: SNO-FLO™ was specifically designed as a solution for State DOT's, Municipal Street Departments, County Highway Departments and Private Contractors to reduce the frustration of snow and ice slush sticking to vehicles and de-icing equipment used during winter storm operations. As an added bonus SNO-FLO™ also improves safety by reducing snow fog from covering up your warning lights.

USES: SNO-FLO™ can be used to give you three main benefits:

- 1. PREVENTS SNOW & ICE STICKING** - on the faces of your plows, blower chutes, loader buckets, grader blades, vehicle dump beds, and even prevents the formation of snow pack under wheel-wells.
- 2. GREATLY REDUCES SHOVELING FATIGUE** - shoveling is a heavy job without the added weight of snow sticking to your shovel. Keep your shovel clean with SNO-FLO™.
- 3. IMPROVES SAFETY FOR ALL** - by reducing snow fog which covers up your vehicle warning lights and the back of your spreaders and trucks.

APPLICATION: For the best results, always apply SNO-FLO™ with Rhomar's 25-Gallon portable sprayer with the 25' hose and pistol grip handle which allow jet stream or fan spray application. For smaller areas use Rhomar's 3-Gallon Big Mouth Applicator.

APPLICATION OF SNO-FLO™: Apply SNO-FLO™ in the following ways:

- 1. PRE-STORM** - simply spray SNO-FLO™ directly onto your equipment and vehicles that you want protected from snow and ice slush build-up, approximately one (1) to three (3) hours prior to usage. Reapply new SNO-FLO™ when sticking becomes visible, usually after twelve (12) to twenty-four (24) hours of snow fighting activities.

- **PREVENTS STICKING** - And the aggravation of snow build-up, even at sub-zero temperatures!
- **LESS FRUSTRATION** - Drivers are focused on driving and not snow & ice build-up!
- **GREAT** - On snow plows, blowers, blades & shovels!
- **VERSATILE** - Also great in dump beds that haul dirt, mud & other excavations!
- **SAVES MONEY & TIME** - Reduces man hours and fuel cost due to weight of snow!
- **IMPROVES SAFETY** - Reduces snow fog on warning lights and backs of vehicles!

- 2. DURING WINTER STORM OPERATIONS** - Apply SNO-FLO™ to snow accumulations on your equipment to break the bond between the snow and ice and the metal surface. Reapply SNO-FLO™ once the accumulations are removed to prevent further snow and ice slush build-up.
- 3. ON THE GO** - you may apply SNO-FLO™ directly to a wet or dry surface.



WARNING
